

Invitation to a Shropshire Way Guided Walk

The Shropshire Way Challenge is for members of Girl Guiding Shropshire, between us, to walk the entire 200 miles of the newly way marked Shropshire Way between Thinking Day 2020 and Thinking Day 2022.

You can do as much or little as you like, every step counts, and all participants can gain a badge for taking part. Below are details of a **short** walk which is another of a series of guided walks on parts of the Shropshire Way.

Date: Saturday 30th October

Section of the Shropshire way: Little Wenlock to Coalbrookdale

Route description:

- The first section is from Little Wenlock Community Centre and gently down hill and across farmland.
- The second section is down through the woods bordering the Coalbrook. There should be lots of interesting toadstools to spot at this time of year.

Total distance:

About 4km or 2½ miles. It should not take more than 2 hours, more like 1¾ hours.

Who is for?:

Any member of Shropshire Guiding of any age who is able to walk unaided. This route is not suitable for anyone with impaired mobility. Leaders are welcome to bring members of their unit provided the adult: girl ratio is observed.

Starting time and place:

2p.m. Little Wenlock Community Centre, Malthouse Bank, Little Wenlock TF6 SBN.

Finish time and place:

About 3:45 p.m. car park of Coalbrookdale Community centre car park 2 Wellington Rd, Coalbrookdale, Telford TF8 7DX.

Cost: £0. Shropshire way badge £1 +p&p can be ordered from Marion Wynn.
